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CPD Requirements





Compliance Requirements

- Completion of the online annual declaration by 1 February each year;
- Recording of at least six (6) CPD activities; and
- Maintaining an electronic portfolio of evidence.
- Pharmacists are encouraged to submit at least
 1 entry every 2nd month.

No manual submissions

The Annual Declaration

- Based on competency standards for pharmacists approved by Council in February 2018
 - Domains
 - Competency standards
 - Behavioural statements
- Results in designation as practising or non-practising
- To be submitted by 1 February each year

Auto designation to practising

Designation of Persons

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- According to Regulation 4(1) of *Regulations relating to continuing professional development* a person may choose to be designated as either practising or non-practising.
 - Practising the registered person is currently providing one or more of the services, or performing one or more of the acts, pertaining to their scope of practice
 - * "Non-practising" the registered person is currently not providing one or more of the services, or performing one or more of the acts, pertaining to their scope of practice

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Domains and Competencies Explained DOMAIN 1: PUBLIC HEALTH

Does this domain apply to me?

The domain applies to all pharmacists whose practice includes promotion of health and wellness through the provision of healthcare information and education to the public and other members of the healthcare team

INTRODUCTION

Domain 1 covers public health and includes competencies that are required in both the public and private healthcare sectors to promote health and wellness through the provision of healthcare information and education to the public and other members of the healthcare team.

The provision of medicines and healthcare information and education forms an integral part of the scope of practice of a pharmacist. The availability of specialised pharmaceutical knowledge at all levels of care, including primary healthcare (PHC), is an important component for the delivery of effective and efficient pharmaceutical services.

The domain covers competencies that are required to promote health, promote and monitor adherence and apply pharmacoeconomic principles.

COMPETENCIES

- 1.1 Promotion of health and wellness
- 1.2 Medicines information
- 1.3 Professional and health advocacy
- 1.4 Health economics
- 1.5 Epidemic and disaster management
- 1.6 Primary healthcare

The public health domain competencies are:

A person who has achieved this standard is able to demonstrate the following behaviours:

- (a) Provide advice on health promotion.
- (b) Provide advice on disease prevention and control.
- (c) Provide advice on healthy lifestyles.
- (d) Participate in public health campaigns.

Assessment (Tick appropriate box)

Pharmacy Practice is not restricted to the provision of direct clinical care only.

- It includes working in a direct non-clinical relationship with clients, administration, education, research, advisory, regulatory or policy development roles; and
- Any other roles that impact on the safe, effective delivery of services in the profession

- Your obligation is to choose CPD activities relevant to your scope of practice.
- However, you are not precluded from choosing other types of CPD if this information is useful in our personal development







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Continuing Professional Development

- Definition: the process by which registered persons maintain and enhance their competence throughout their professional careers
- Encompasses a range of activities including continuing education and supplementary training
- CPD enables registered persons to develop in their area of practice and demonstrate competence



CPD is a cyclical activity







CPD Submission Process

- You need to submit 6 CPD entries > There are two different cycles to pick from
- 4 Step CPD cycle
 - \succ There are no limitations on the CPD activities
 - Requires prior planning and outline
 - > Allows submission once all four steps are completed
- 2 Step CPD cycle
 - Limited to 3 CPD activities per year
 - >Instant
 - > Follows no thought process

What constitutes a good CPD activity?

- Learning title: ensure that the title is appropriate and relevant to the domain.
- Learning need: What knowledge gaps do you seek to fill?
- Learning method/activity: will this be measurable, non-measurable or structured.
- Learning outcome: what have you learnt and how did it improve your skills?





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Learning Activities







Self study, case study, conferences, etc. Short course, review an article, invited guest, etc. Diploma, postgraduate studies.

2021 CPD Compliance Year

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➢Grace period ends 30 April 2022

- Non-compliant pharmacists_ designated as nonpractising
- If RP or tutor_ referral for disciplinary action

2022 CPD Compliance Year

Must submit at least 1 entry every 2 months
 Submission deadline – 31 December 2022
