## SAPC e-Note: IGNORE LETTERS INDICATING DESIGNATION AS NON-PRACTISING AND REQUESTING REASONS FOR NON-COMPLIANCE WITH 2020 CPD REQUIREMENTS

You recently received letters indicating that you have been designated as non-practising due to noncompliance with Continuing Professional Development (CPD) requirements and requesting reasons not to be subjected to disciplinary action. These letters were sent to you erroneously as they were meant only for non-compliant pharmacists not occupying the roles of Responsible Pharmacist and/or Tutor.

As you are a Responsible Pharmacist/Tutor, your non-compliance with CPD requirements is dealt with differently. As such, we trust that the Professional Conduct Department of the South African Pharmacy Council will/has been in touch with you to indicate the process to be followed in the case of your non-compliance.
