SAPC e-Note: REMOVAL OF PHARMACY REGISTRATION/RECORDING FROM THE REGISTER OF COUNCIL

In terms of Regulation 72 of the Regulations relating to the registration of persons and the maintenance of registers, Council may direct the Registrar to remove from the register of pharmacies, the name of a pharmacy if the pharmacy fails to comply with the Rules relating to Good Pharmacy Practice (GPP) as published by Council in terms of Section 35A of the Pharmacy Act, 53 of 1974.

The following pharmacies have been removed from Council's registers but continue to operate despite their removal. Do not supply medicines to any of the following:

- Emfihlweni Pharmacy - Y55501;
- Ecaleni Pharmacy – Y54724; and
- Dispharm Pharmacy – Y55288.

It is your responsibility as the Responsible Pharmacist to ensure that the pharmacy ordering medicines is duly registered in terms of the Pharmacy Act, 53 of 1974.
